EQUIPMENT / SUPPLIES

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71 NATIONAL INTERAGENCY RADIO SUPPORT CACHE (NIRSC)

For a complete listing of NIRSC telecommunications equipment, refer to the National Incident Radio Support Cache User's Guide, NFES # 0968, or the NWCG Fire Supplies and Equipment Catalog, Part 1, NFES # 0362.

All communications equipment, ATMUs, FRAWS and/or PRAWS kits are ordered as Equipment.

71.1 PREPOSITION RADIO KITS

The Eastern Area Coordination Center will preposition four Starter System ICS Command/Logistics Radios (NFES #4390) across the Eastern Area.

Prepositioned radio kits will be stored in a secure location. The location does not have to be environmentally controlled. (ie - storage building or garage)

Prepositioned radio kits, that have in storage for more than 1 year, will have extra batteries shipped with the kit.

Requests for the preposition radio equipment will be made through established dispatch channels from EACC to NICC.

When there is a need to request one of the 4390 prepositioned systems for a local incident, the requesting unit must submit an equipment request through appropriate dispatch channels via ROSS to EACC. NIRSC will be contacted by EACC to coordinate system assignments. EACC will work closely with host dispatch centers to expedite mobilization of the starter system. EACC will notify NICC of the radio equipment commitment to an incident within the Eastern Area.

The 4390 systems in their entirety will be returned to NIRSC for refurbishment after kits are no longer needed by an incident.

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EACC will be responsible for backfill of committed systems. During high levels of national activity, NICC will direct EACC to ship system(s) to out-of-area incident(s) and backfill will not be necessary.

All radio kits must be ordered as Equipment requests through normal dispatch channels to the Eastern Area Coordination Center for processing.

**74 ATMOSPHERIC THEODOLITE METEOROLOGICAL UNIT (ATMU)
(NFES #1836)**

Atmospheric Theodolite Meteorological Unit (ATMU) will be requested on an Equipment order through established ordering channels using ROSS. Mobilization of ATMUs is not automatic. They will be mobilized only upon request from the Incident Meteorologist. See also EMG, Ch. 20, sections 23.5 and 22.7 for IMET.

74.1 INFRARED DEVICES

There are several types of infrared devices available within the interagency fire system that are used for locating hot areas on wildfires. These may be ordered through EACC from the Northeast Interagency Fire Cache.

Dynoptics Fire Finder II, NFES 0759 –this is an infrared heat sensor, flashlight type handheld model. It is operational by using two standard nine-volt radio batteries. There are five units available.

Camera, Heat Detector, Raytheon Thermal Infrared Camera, Palm IR-250, NFES 7833 - Three camera kits are available. The self-contained unit runs on one Nickel Metal Hydride Rechargeable Camera battery (kit contains four batteries and chargers) with an operational life of eight hours per battery.
