2007 Weather Review

Combined low snow pack, early melt off, record breaking high temperatures and below normal precipitation during the 2007 fire season created the right conditions for extreme fire behavior across Eastern Great Basin.

Winter 2006-2007


Below normal winter snow pack plagued the intermountain west prior to the fire season. Much below normal snow was observed in December and January followed by a few good storms in February.

March – June 2007


Early spring melt-off began in March as warm temperatures spread across the west. Conditions remained warm and dry through June. . One significant wet storm moved across the northern 2/3 of the region at the binning of June, followed by dry cold fronts for warm, windy weather and overall below normal precipitation.

July 2007

By the end of the first week of July the long, hot dry streak of June was broken as moisture entered eastern Utah for a large outbreak of dry thunderstorms across much of the state. This moisture began to spread north into Idaho and Wyoming by mid month and thunderstorm events were frequently followed by strong winds. Thunderstorms began to moisten up in the south by the 2nd and 3rd weeks of July. By the end of the month another surge of moisture came up from the south, producing scattered high precipitation amounts across Utah and eastern Idaho/western Wyoming. Western Idaho received the least amount of rain for the month.

August 2007

Upper level high pressure dominated the weather during the month of August for above normal temperatures area wide with maximums occurring across northern Utah. With the ridge oscillating near the four corners region for most of the month, moisture from the south was able to continue to move into the Great Basin for episodes of thunderstorms at the beginning of the month, mid-month, and toward the end. These storms were most numerous and wet across southern and eastern Utah. Southeast Idaho and western Wyoming saw near normal precipitation while western Idaho stayed well below normal for the month of August with very little thunderstorm activity. A few strong wind events moved across the northern half of the area during the month followed by weak, mostly dry cool fronts.


September 2007

August weather continued into the first half of September with more frequent dry frontal passages and isolated thunderstorms across the north. A series of significantly cooler and moister systems moved through Idaho/western Wyoming mid-late month for an end to extreme fire behavior.



Preparedness Level Review

Fire season started slow moving to preparedness level two on June 3 and staying there until June 22. After a slow June, fire season came with a vengeance, By July 5 we were in level five and remained there until September 9. By mid-September activity gradually slowed reaching preparedness level one on October 7. Eastern Great Basin experienced 65 days in preparedness level five which is much above normal. Nationally only 49 days were in preparedness level five in 2007.



2007 Season Review

A very active fire season prevailed caused by a low snow pack, early melt off, record breaking temperatures and below normal precipitation. Lightning caused fires decreased by 20% compared to the 5 year average. The five year average is 1,794 compared to 1,435 in 2007. The human caused fires on the other hand experienced an increased 24%. The five year average is 793 compared to 1,048 in 2007. Total fires for 2007 was 2,483 compared to 2,587 for the five year average. While the number of fires was below the five year average, the number of acres burned increased 75%. Total acres burned in 2007 were 2,411,578 compared to the five year average of 593,633 and 1,244,452 acres in last year. Utah had the most fires with 1,423 and Idaho the most acres burned with 1,738,710. The State/Private had the most fires with 950 and the Bureau of Land Management had the most acres burned with 1,097,839 followed closely by the Forest Service with 944,689.

The first large fire occurred April 18th on the Cedar City District BLM. The first Type 2 Team mobilization occurred June 19th on the Bridger-Teton National Forest, followed by the first Type 1 mobilization on June 30th on the BIA, Unitah and Ouray Agencies. The last large fire of the season was on Idaho Falls South District, BLM and occurred September 17th. A break down of large fires by month is found below:

Seven day coverage at EBGCC began on May 29th and continued through September 30th. There were 26 detail assignments in the Coordination Center this season.

The Great Basin Multi-agency Coordinating (MAC) Group was activated July 8th through July 31st at Western Great Basin. The Great Basin MAC Group was active for a total of 24 days. Three Area Command orders were placed for the large fires in Idaho this past season. The Area Command Teams spent a total of 61 days in Idaho.

Large Fire Activity Review

There were 218 large fires in Eastern Great Basin this season. This is more than two times the previous five year average of 86 large fires.

Large fires are classified as 100 acres or larger in timber fuel types, 300 acres or larger in grass fuel types, or when a Type 1 or Type 2 Incident Management Team is assigned. This also includes Wildland Fire Use incidents. The following is a summary of large fires for 2007 based on Incident Status Summaries (ICS-209's) received in Eastern Great Basin.









Eastern Great Basin Resource Orders


2007 GREAT BASIN TYPE 2 TEAM ASSIGNMENTS




2007 GREAT BASIN TYPE 2 TEAM DAYS ON ASSIGNMENT
