<p><b>Predictive Services:</b> ...Cooling &amp; Moistening Trend...</p> <p>Clouds have moved into many northern and central areas along with much higher humidity levels. Some spotty light showers have already occurred across the mountains of Western ID. Spotty sprinkles or light showers today will become steadier and more widespread across ID by late Fri thru the weekend. Areas of Northern NV and parts of UT will also see some scattered shower activity. Precipitation amounts in Central Idaho are expected to range from 0.35 to 0.75 inches during this 4-day stretch of cool, moist weather...with lesser amounts and spottier coverage further south. Snow levels in ID on Saturday could drop down to 6000 ft.</p> <p>Another weak disturbance late Sunday into Monday in the north...otherwise a gradual return to near normal temperature/humidity by early next week, but no extreme heat or dryness is expected.</p>	<p><b>Predictive Services :</b> Basil Newmerzhicky</p>
