The northern half of the Great Basin has seen long duration high humidity along with many areas getting wetting rains, especially across Idaho and Wyoming, as well as far northern Nevada and Utah. Areas further south also experienced some cooling and moistening...along with more wetting rains across eastern areas of Utah. A weaker system should brush our northern areas Tuesday with more clouds, cooler temperatures' and scattered light showers, mainly Idaho. Afterwards, a gradual warming and drying trend develops. The southern half of the Great Basin will see warming/drying for all areas this coming week.
