No changes with the 209.

Indirect line has been completed. Rehab efforts continue. The fire is going to re-establish the Lowman ICP and will be all set up by Thursday. Garden Valley will be demobed as resources time out. Look for big demob on Wed/Thurs Will be looking at putting hard lines into Lowman for communication.

Did get some precip across the area between .01 and .2 inches of rain. The RHs are up today, but WX will start to dry out over the weekend. The fire is not expected to stand up but it is burning within the interior.

Branch 2 : South of HWY 17: Will monitor this side of the fire.  
Rehab is almost done and will continue to monitor.

Branch 1 : East side: north of HWY 17.  
Rehab and clean up continues.

No injuries or accidents to report.

<p><b>2</b>  <b>Fire: Range Creek</b>  <b>IC: Zach Palmer</b></p>	<p>30 / 0% / 150,000 / 120</p> <p>Fire is located between the Range Creek drainage and Range Creek Road and the ridge line to the South. Poor access and steep terrain to the fire. If the incident gets substantial rain there could be egress issues for all ground resources.</p> <p>Had some slop over on the ridge top, but working hard to hold that ridge. Looking at doing a check line due to steep terrain and inaccessible areas along that South ridge.</p> <p>Land owners are extremely involved at the briefings and very concerned of their private property.</p> <p>No injuries to report  No resource needs.</p>
