
Location: Jackson Ranger District-BTNF, south of Jackson Hole Mountain Resort, underneath 4 Pines in the Pinedale drainage south of Rock Springs.

Cause— Likely lightning from one of the several storms the week of 7/24/2023

Acres-.01 - Single dead tree (snag)

Fuels— Subalpine fir, spruce and older dead and down timber. Standing dead timber

Special Considerations- Rock Springs fire is located in very steep rocky terrain. As with all wildfires, there is risk to firefighter's and the steep slope is an added risk. Fire managers are developing a strategy for the fire which includes public and firefighter safety in this steep terrain as a primary objective. The fire has low spread potential and is surrounded by rock and open meadows.
