CONTINUOUS MONITORING OF THE AIR GUARD FREQUENCY, 168.6250, TX tone 110.9 (Narrow Band)

IS REQUIRED OF TACTICAL AIRCRAFT AND DISPATCH OFFICES

Use of this frequency is limited to emergency air-to-air or air-to-ground communication, use as an initial contact frequency when no other contact frequency is available, or as a means of recalling or redirecting aircraft.

NATIONAL AIR TANKER BASE FREQUENCY 123.975*

NATIONAL FLIGHT FOLLOWING FREQUENCY 168.650, RX and TX tone 110.9 (Narrow Band)

NATIONAL SMOKEJUMPER AIR-GROUND FREQUENCY 168.5500 (Narrow)

DO NOT USE ANY FREQUENCIES UNLESS AUTHORIZED GOVERNMENT TRAVEL FREQUENCIES 163.1000 and 168.3500

These are common use narrow band frequencies and are authorized for use by ground units in transit throughout the country.

Part 95.1301 of the FCC Rules and Regulations describes the Multi-Use Radio Service (MURS) operating on 151.820, 151.880, 151.940, 154.570, and 154.600, Part 632. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has authorized these frequencies for unlicensed use by the public. However, NTIA has **NOT** authorized them for use by federal users. They are susceptible to high levels of interference with no recourse. **Due to the unprotected and uncontrolled use of these frequencies by the public, USDA agencies will not conduct official business on any of these frequencies. Official radio communications should be conducted using spectrum that is allotted to government and is authorized in accordance the NTIA Manual.**

The mode of all VHF-FM frequencies are noted as “Narrow” band or “Wide” band; any programming questions, contact the agency communications technician or visit <http://radios.nifc.gov/>

IMPORTANT REMINDER: *These frequencies are issued for use by the agency under which they are listed. They may be used by other agencies in emergency situations. However, the only frequencies that may be preprogrammed into an agency's radios are those specifically issued to that agency.*
