Remarks:

Northwest will implement NMAC direction on Area Command and Type 1 & 2 Incident Management Team (IMT) mobilization under PL-5 as follows:

- The Northwest is committed to providing IMTs to support national needs.
- The “rationale worksheet” is required by NMAC for Area Command, WFU Teams, Type 1 IMTs, and for any reassignment of an out-of-area Type 2 IMT working in the Northwest.
- Rationale worksheets are not required for Type 2 IMT mobilizations or reassignments in Washington or Oregon unless the request is forwarded to NICC for processing.
- Federal Type 2 IMTs in Oregon are available for national assignment. Washington Interagency IMTs will be available based upon NW Preparedness Level and the number of available teams.
- A drawdown level for Type 2 IMTs for national assignment will be based upon the availability of NW Type 2 IMTs and the predicted need.

Please use Change-1 of the Demob guidelines, issued on 8/4/06, which adds to the direction issued on 8/3/06.
