Remarks: A shortage of resources continues to exist for the number of ongoing and emerging incidents within the Pacific Northwest. The allocation and reassignment of resources will follow this NW MAC group strategy:

1. Dispatch of initial attack resources will continue to follow mobilization procedures outlined in the NW Mobilization Guide, Chapter 20, page 8, 21.2.3 – Neighborhood Concept.
2. Assignment and reassignment of regional and nationally shared resources need to be coordinated with and approved by NW MAC.
3. Assigning and reassignment of area and national incident management teams, area command and wildland fire use teams will be coordinated by NW MAC.
4. Assignment and reassignment of critical shortage resources (for example: Type II hand crews, mid-level fire line leadership, helicopter management and safety officers) will be coordinated and approved by NW MAC.
