### Remarks:

NW MAC decisions and strategies issued since July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2006 are amended in the following manner and are effective with this issuance:

- “Neighborhood” ordering practices outlined in the 2006 Northwest Mobilization Guide (section 21.2.3) are re-instituted.
- A “Rationale Worksheet” is no longer by NW MAC. The requirement for Area Command, Type 1 or 2 IMT’s, and WFU’s by National MAC may still be in effect for a period of time. Check with NWCC if an NMAC requirement would apply at the time of any future 2006 requests.
- Incident Prioritization Worksheets will no longer be required from Incident Commanders after Monday, Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> except as needed, if activity picks up again this season.
