* As most of the large incidents in northern Washington approach containment the focus shifts to preparations for an increase in initial attack associated with lightning predicted for parts of the Pacific Northwest. Field units are encouraged to assess the availability of resources to support the ongoing effort and the new activity expected from the predicted lightning.
