4	Shadow Lake	DEF	Gage	Active fire behavior; high public exposure along Hwy 126
5	High Cascades Complex	WSA	Goff	Badger Butte fire threat to tribal timber value; high firefighter exposure
6	Little Butte	ORCA	Fillis	Threat to high value timber lands and Boy Scout Camp
7	Big Hump	NW WA	Johnson	High public interest
8	Mother Lode	MHF	Wilstead	Wilderness
