3	High Cascades Complex	WSA	Fillis/Goff	Smoke impact on major highways, holiday weekend; heavy mop-up occurring
4	Shadow Lake	DEF	Gage	Increased fire activity visible from major highway; holiday weekend
5	Salmon	NES	Johnson	Anticipate containment today
