2	Dollar Lake	MHF	West	Bull Run Watershed and private lands threat; west side is unsecured; burn out operations; high visibility from major metro area
3	High Cascades Complex	WSA	Fillis/Goff	Badger Butte fire threat to tribal timber value; direct attack on the west side
4	Shadow Lake	DEF	Gage	Active fire but still within strategic objectives; high visibility from hwy; holiday weekend
