| <b>2</b>        | Dollar Lake           | MHF         | West        | Bull Run Watershed and private lands threat; burn out operations; high visibility from major metro area    |
| <b>3</b>        | Shadow Lake           | DEF         | Gage        | Active fire behavior; high public exposure along Hwy 126   |
| <b>4</b>        | High Cascades Complex | WSA         | Fillis/Goff | Badger Butte fire threat to tribal timber value; direct attack on the west side; high firefighter exposure |
| <b>5</b>        | Big Hump              | NW WA       | Johnson     | No IPW received  |
