1. Maintain strong initial attack stance in anticipation of lightning
2. Continue to support large incidents and look for opportunities for early containment
3. Identify resources for ready reserve (IMT activation), potential reallocation or surge task force

4	Taylor Bridge	WA SES	Reed	Reduced evacuation levels, Hwy 97 reopened, initial containment in critical areas
5	Waterfalls 2	OR WSA	Williams	Working towards indirect containment strategy
6	Butte	OR UPF	Fillis	Utilizing direct and indirect strategies, no fire growth
7	10 Mile Complex	OR VAD	Pendleton	90% contained; includes Holloway North Zone
