### Strategic Intent:

1. Maintain strong initial attack stance in anticipation of lightning
2. Continue to support large incidents and look for opportunities for early containment
3. Identify resources for ready reserve (IMT activation), staging at RAC MOB, stagger crew rotation to manage fatigue and crew availability

4	Butte	OR UPF	Fillis	Fire completely lined, continue to ensure high probability of success to meet incident objectives
5	Barry Point	OR FWF	Morcom	Line construction completed, mop up and patrol status, National Guard remains assigned
6	10 Mile Complex	OR VAD	Pendleton	Completing rehab, schedule transition Tuesday
