Strategic Intent:

1. Maintain strong initial attack stance in anticipation of predicted wind event
2. Continue to support large incidents and look for opportunities for early containment and reallocation of assets
3. Identify resources for ready reserve (IMT activation), staging at RAC MOB, stagger crew rotation to manage fatigue and crew availability

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

1	Initial Attack			
2	Waterfalls 2	OR WSA	Williams	Active fire behavior, 5% containment, aerial ignition planned
3	Diamond Butte	WA YAA	Johnson	Limited information, potential for additional resource needs
4	Taylor Bridge	WA SES	Reed	Mop up and patrol status, evacuations still in effect
5	Barry Point	OR FWF	Morcom	National Guard assets still assigned, mop up and patrol status
6	Butte	OR UPF	Fillis	Fire completely lined and plumbed, local unit requesting IMT to remain assigned for support
