### Strategic Intent:

- Repositioning of resources in anticipation of increased initial attack activity
- Support critical missions to maximize resource effectiveness and to protect life and infrastructure
- Reallocate resources and assign surge task force as necessary
- Focus on replacement as resources time out

2	Wenatchee Complex	WA-OWF	Pendleton	Covers larger geographic area; more communities threatened than Table Mountain
3	Table Mountain	WA-OWF	Reed	Increasing complexity; transition to type 1 IMT tomorrow
4	Okanogan Complex	WA-OWF	Williams	Fire behavior and terrain are making access and establishing anchor points difficult
5	Pole Creek	OR-DEF	Watts	Close to meeting incident objectives; TOC tentatively scheduled for 9/26
6	Yakima Complex	WA-OWF	Johnson	Wildrose containment imminent
7	Cascade Creek	WA-GPF	LaFave	Lower values at risk; tentative TOC 9/26
