6	Pole Creek	OR-DEF	Watts	Active fire and some spotting; transfer of command back to local unit scheduled for 9/26
7	Cascade Creek	WA-GPF	LaFave	Fire continues to burn actively in the wilderness; transfer of command to another Type 2 team on 9/24
8	Yakima Complex	WA-OWF	Johnson	Wildrose containment imminent; transfer of command to Type 3 IMT on 9/25
