2	Table Mountain	WA-OWF	Morcom	Firing operations around communities, unprotected structures, assessing open fire lines,
3	Wenatchee Complex	WA-OWF	Pendleton	Changing strategies, transitioning to another Type 1 team, coordinating with Table Mountain fire,
4	Goat	WA-OWF	Leitch	Active fire behavior, terrain is making access difficult, level 2 and 3 evacuations still in place
5	Cascade Creek	WA-GPF	Nickey	Mopping up, transfer of command Wednesday 9-26
6	Okanogan Complex	WA-OWF	Williams	Fire continues to burn actively, assessing where to establish direct and indirect lines
7	Pole Creek	OR-DEF	Watts	Control lines in place, completing firing operations, transfer of command on Saturday 9-29
8	Yakima Complex	WA-OWF	Johnson	Transfer of command to Type 3 on Tuesday 9-25
