### Strategic Intent:

- Collaborate and provide support for SW OR Sub GEO MAC.
- Prepare for increased initial attack and provide support for replacements to meet long- term resource needs.
- Provide support for incidents with short-duration critical missions.

<b>2</b>	Douglas Complex	OR-DFPA (732)	Sifford	SW OR MAC	Multiple values at risk; unsecured line with potential growth to the southwest; reducing evacuation levels
<b>3</b>	Whiskey Complex	OR-UPF	Williams	SW OR MAC	High concern for industrial/timber lands; firing operations ongoing; primary containment line breached
<b>4</b>	Big Windy Complex	OR-MED	Schulte	SW OR MAC	Continue with big box strategy; firing operations ongoing; structures are immediately threatened
<b>5</b>	Green Ridge-Cascade Division complex	OR-DEF	Minton		Changed to indirect strategy on the south and west flank; containment date predicted for 8/10
<b>6</b>	Colockum Tarps	WA-WFS	Nickey		High probability of containment; no critical resource needed; aerial ignition planned for today
<b>7</b>	Labrador	OR-RSF	Fillis	SW OR MAC	Long-term confinement strategy; TOC 0600 8/8
