2	Douglas Complex	OR-DFPA (732)	Sifford	SW OR MAC	Multiple values at risk; unsecured line with potential growth to the southwest; increasing number of spot fires
3	Big Windy Complex	OR-MED	Schulte	SW OR MAC	Continue with big box strategy; firing operations ongoing; incident received precipitation
4	GC complex	OR-MAF	Watts		Implementing direct strategy; fire received precipitation; potential short duration
5	Colockum Tarps	WA-WFS	Nickey		High probability of containment; no critical resource needed; burn out should be completed today; transitioning to T3 on 8/11; mop-up and patrol status
6	Whiskey Complex	OR-UPF	Williams	SW OR MAC	High concern for industrial/timber lands; firing operations delayed due to precipitation on the fire; TOC to T2 IMT on 8/11
7	Green Ridge-Cascade Division complex	OR-DEF	Minton		Containment date predicted for 8/11; fire behavior moderate; all lines held; precipitation in forecast
