3	Big Windy Complex	OR-MED	Lewis		Implementing best containment strategy considering firefighter exposure; drying conditions are allowing for burn-out
4	Whiskey Complex	OR-UPF	Johnson		Drying conditions are allowing for burn-out; high concern for industrial/timber lands
5	Milepost 10	WA-SES	Barnett		State mobilization released; heavy precipitation received on the fire; reduced threat to community
6	GC Complex	OR-MAF	Watts		Containment lines completed around all fires; mop-up in progress; releasing critical resources
7	Westside Complex	WA-COA	Leitch		All incidents are lined; expectation of new IA support
