2	Mile Marker 28	WA-YAA	Rabe	Best opportunity for containment.
3	Douglas Complex	DFPA/ODF	Sifford	Active fire behavior, community of Glendale threatened with evacuations, road closures, and railroad impacted.
4	Whiskey Complex	OR-UPF	Williams	Historic structures and private timberlands at risk.
5	Labrador	OR-RSF	Fillis	Limited access due to smoke; structure protection in Oak Flat area.
6	Sunnyside Turnoff	OR-WSA	Watts	Containment is imminent.
