Strategic Intent:

- Follow Strategic Risk Assessment as necessary.
- Plan strategically for all suppression resources to recognize and adjust for the long term need.
- Continue to allocate/reallocate critical resources in support of IA, emerging large fires and incidents with short duration critical missions.

| 3 | Big Windy Complex | OR-MED | Lewis | | Long duration burn-out operations; critical resources will be timing out |
| 4 | Douglas Complex | OR-DFPA (732) | Sifford | | Line construction complete; continuing with burn-out operations |
| 5 | Whiskey Complex | OR-UPF | Johnson | | Burn-out operations continuing; area closures still in place |
| 6 | Conrad Lake | WA-OWF | Allbee | | Preparing direct and indirect lines; no critical resource needs |
