3	Carlton Complex	WA-NES	P. Blume	81% containment; new fire in the complex called Rising Eagle near Winthrop as a result four new evacuation areas have been identified
4	Chiwaukum Complex	WA-NES	M. Dueitt	29% containment; active fire behavior; Hwy 2 has been opened with restricted speed limit
5	Sniption	OR-PRD	D. Johnson	60% containment; TOC local unit 0600 8/4
6	Logging Unit	OR-WSA	R. Williams	70% containment; securing line; reducing closure areas on fire
7	Haystack Complex	OR-952S	J. Buchman	80% containment; anticipated short duration
8	Lone Mountain 1	WA-NCP	J. Thompson	31% containment; TOC at 0600 8/3 to local unit
9	South Fork Complex	OR-PRD	B. Watts	Emerging incident IMT2 assigned; per MAC reps priority
10	Camp Creek Complex	OR-RSF	E. Lewis	Emerging incident IMT1 assigned; per MAC reps priority
11	Mills Canyon	WA-SES	M. Dueitt	98% containment; patrol status
