Strategic Intent:

1. Limit duration of incidents with fine fuel component
2. Promote sharing of resources as incident proximity allows
3. Maximize efficiency of resource allocation given limited information from many incidents

5	Mills Canyon	WA-SES	E. Lewis	Chiwaukum Creek Fire threat to Leavenworth
6	Bridge 99 Complex	OR- DEF	B. Fillis	Beal Butte Fire (#318) has burned onto Warm Springs Agency land
7	Pittsburgh	OR-WWF	B. Johnson	Logistical challenges with access
8	Bingham Complex	OR-WIF	L. Nickey	Wilderness; long duration fire
9	Carlton Complex	WA-NES	N. Rabe	Emerging incident: Type 2 team assigned
