Strategic Intent:

1. Allocate resources based on critical mission and incident priority.
2. Identify critical resources for surge capacity in support of initial attack and extended attack.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

1	Initial Attack			Initial Attack always first priority
2	Devil's Elbow Complex	WA-COA	L. Nickey	Level III evacuations; Hwy 21 closed near Republic; critical burn-out operations over the next couple days
3	Snag Canyon	WA-SES	B. Johnson	Level II evacuations in place; major power lines threatened; significant growth; north containment lines lost
4	Duncan (Chiwaukum)	WA-NES	C. Schulte	Level II evacuations in place; active fire behavior
5	Hansel (Chiwaukum Complex)	WA-NES	C. Schulte	Level II evacuations; active fire behavior; critical to keep fire north of Ingalls Creek
6	South Fork Complex	OR-PRD	E. Lewis	Level I evacuations around entire fire; firing operations ongoing
7	Little Bridge Creek	WA-OWF	B. Lund	Level I evacuations; conducting burn-out operations; pursuing indirect strategy
8	Upper Falls (Carlton)	WA-NES	B. Lund	Level I evacuations; critical burn-out operations; multiple suppression strategies
9	Cle Elum Ridge	WA-OWF	B. Allbee	Level I evacuations; direct and indirect strategies
