6	Bridge 99 Complex	OR- DEF	B. Fillis	Level 2 evacuations for communities around Lake Billy Chinook; priority elevated above Buzzard Complex based on NW MAC direction
7	Buzzard Complex	OR-BUD	B. Watts	Extreme fire behavior; rapid rate of spread; Type 1 IMT ordered; no critical resource needs
8	Pittsburg	OR-WWF	B. Johnson	Level 1 evacuations; logistical challenges with access
9	Sunflower	OR-UMF	M. Wilde	Potential short-duration incident
10	Logging Unit	OR-WSA	C. Schulte	Emerging incident; limited information; Type 1 IMT ordered
11	Pine Creek	OR-PRD	B. Fry	Emerging incident; no critical resource needs
