Strategic Intent:

1. Promote sharing of resources as incident proximity allows
2. Support incidents nearing full containment to facilitate getting resources back into the system
3. Prepare to support other Geographic Areas by identifying critical resources that may be reallocated to a higher national need.

3	Chiwaukum Complex	WA-NES	E.Lewis	Includes Duncan and Kelly Mountain Fires; Chiwaukum fire at 10% containment
4	Ochoco Complex	OR-OCF	T. Dunford	Priority ranking per Sub-Geo MAC; Terrain, access and safety issues; potential for spread to private resources
5	Logging Unit	OR-WSA	C. Schulte	Priority ranking per Sub-Geo MAC; risk to commercial timber and Sidwalter residence
6	Sunflower	OR-UMF	M. Wilde	Priority ranking per Sub-Geo MAC
7	Pine Creek	OR-PRD	B. Fry	Priority ranking per Sub-Geo MAC
8	Waterman Complex	OR-952S	D. Johnson	Priority ranking per Sub-Geo MAC
9	Bridge 99 Complex	OR- DEF	B. Fillis	Priority ranking per Sub Geo MAC
10	Buzzard Complex	OR-BUD	B. Watts/ G.Poncin	No critical needs; heavy demob
