4	Whitewater	OR-WIF	E. Knerr	Impacts to private timber sales; trail and area closures in affect.
5	Spruce Creek	OR-CLP	B. Gales	Major fire run towards Crater Lake National Park. Rim Road closed to public.
6	Noisy Creek	WA-COF	N. Rabe	Road Closures in affect; impacting recreation.
7	Suiattle	WA-NWS	R. Harrod	Threats to private timberlands; potential long-term incident
