5	Noisy Creek	WA-COF	N. Rabe	Level 2 evacuation notice for burnout operations; several trail and road closures; progress being made towards incident objectives.
6	Whitewater	OR-WIF	E. Knerr	Impacts to timber sales; trail and area closures in effect. Potential for westward fire spread. Planning transition to Type 1 IMT. Anticipating impacts from public due to Eclipse event.
7	Bear Butte	OR-WWF	B. Goff	Level 1 evacuation notice still in place. Mop-up continues.
