Strategic Intent:

1. Assess Geographic Area resources currently assigned and determine additional incident needs.
2. Develop situational awareness into the weekend and next week in anticipation of critical fire weather events and associated resource needs.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

| <u>Priority</u> | <u>Fire</u> | <u>Unit</u> | <u>IC</u> | <u>Rationale</u> |
|-----------------|----------------------|-------------|---------------|---|
| 1 | Initial Attack | | | Initial Attack always first priority. |
| 2 | Substation | OR-PRD | Schulte/Yocum | Multiple communities at Level 3 evacuation. |
| 3 | Garner Complex | OR-712S | Cline | Level 2 Evacuations for 70+ Structures. |
| 4 | Hendrix | OR-RSF | Harrod | Level 3 evacuations for rural residences and threat to Ashland Watershed. |
| 5 | South Umpqua Complex | OR-UPF | Sheldon | Twenty plus incidents with threats to private timberlands. |
| 6 | Sugar Pine | OR-RSF | Gales | Threats to recreation and timber resources. |
| 7 | Natchez | OR-RSF | Lawson | Threats to timber resources and power lines. |
