National Preparedness Level	Northwest Preparedness Level
4	4

Strategic Intent:

1. Prepare for additional large fires in southwest, south central, and central Oregon likely to result from lightning on Sunday, 7/22.
2. Anticipate additional resource needs on existing large fires as a result of the continued degradation of the fire environment.
3. Assess resource availability across the remainder of the Geographic Area to determine response capability for initial attack and intermittent large fires.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial Attack always first priority.
2	Garner Complex	OR-712S	Cline/Magers	Several residences at level III. Taylor Fire moving south. Unified Command with OSFM.
3	Hendrix	OR-RSF	Harrod/Buckman	Level III evacuations for rural residences and threat to Ashland watershed.
4	South Umpqua Complex	OR-UPF	Sheldon/Thornton	Seven residences in level II evacuation. Snowshoe crossed jurisdictional boundaries. Unified Command with ODF.
5	Klondike-Granite	OR-RSF	Lawson	Fires combined. Oak Flat at a level II evacuation.
6	Timber Crater 6	OR-CLP	Goff	Threat to Hwy 138 and Fremont-Winema NF.
7	Sugar Pine	OR-RSF	Gales	Recreation and timber resources. Initial attack continues.
