National Preparedness Level	Northwest Preparedness Level
4	4

Strategic Intent:

1. Prepare for additional large fires in southwest, south central, and central Oregon likely to result from lightning currently moving through the Geographic Area.
2. Monitor additional resource needs on existing large fires as a result of the continued degradation of the fire environment.
3. Monitor resource availability across the remainder of the Geographic Area to determine response effectiveness for increasing initial attack, and realign resources as necessary.

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial Attack always first priority.
2	Garner Complex	OR-712S	Cline/Kunze	Hundreds of residences at level III. Taylor fire moving south. Unified Command with OSFM.
3	Natchez	OR-RSF	Livingston	Potential threat to the community of Happy Camp. Opportunity to minimize fire footprint.
4	South Umpqua Complex	OR-UPF	Sheldon/Thornton	Seven residences in level II evacuation. Snowshoe continues to move south. Unified Command with ODF.
5	Hendrix	OR-RSF	Harrod/Buckman	Level III evacuation for rural residences and threat to Ashland watershed. Making progress on objectives.
6	Timber Crater 6	OR-CLP	Goff	Threat to Hwy 138. Progress on securing three flanks.
7	Sugar Pine	OR-RSF	Gales	Sugar Pine and Goodview doubled in size.
