## **Strategic Intent:**

- **1.** Prepare for additional large fires in southwest, south central, and central Oregon likely to result from lightning currently moving through the Geographic Area.
- 2. Monitor additional resource needs on existing large fires as a result of the continued degradation of the fire environment.
- **3.** Monitor resource availability across the remainder of the Geographic Area to determine response effectiveness for increasing initial attack, and realign resources as necessary.

2	Garner Complex	OR-712S	Cline/Magers	132 residences at level III. 1,333 structures threatened. Taylor and Graves actively spotting outside of containment lines. Unified command with OSFM.
3	South Umpqua Complex	OR-UPF	Sheldon/Thorton	Level II evacuation for residences on Tiller Trail Highway due to threat from Snowshoe fire. Columbus likely to merge with the Goodview fire to the south.
4	Natchez	OR-RSF	Livingston	Potential threat to Happy Camp, good progress being made.
5	Sugar Pine	OR-RSF	Gales	Sugar Pine and Goodview continue to be active. Goodview expected to merge with Columbus.
6	Timber Crater 6	OR-CLP	Goff	Threat to Hwy 138. Line completed on three flanks.
7	Klondike	OR-RSF	Livingston	Oak Flat at level III, long-term event, full control strategy. Fire has spotted across the Illinois River.
