Strategic Intent:

- 1. Maintain flexibility in the geographic distribution of Initial Attack resources to efficiently and effectively respond to new starts in the geographic area by:
 - a. reallocating resources for increased Initial Attack and new large fires, as needed;
 - b. maximizing opportunities to fully meet incident objectives through reallocation of critical resources:
 - c. planning for limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC; and by
 - d. determining which resources are necessary to maintain the investments made on long-term incidents should the reallocation of resources become necessary.
- 2. Manage IMTs to effectively respond to complex fires across the Geographic Area to safely meet objectives.

| 5 | Crescent Mt. | WA-OWF | Dueitt | Level II evacuations. Structure protection in place. Wind event could threaten Twisp. |
| 6 | Taylor Creek | OR-MED | Schulte | Level III evacuations. 1500 residences threatened. |
| 7 | Klondike | OR-RSF | Goicochea | Level II and III evacuations. Coordination with Coos Fire Protection Association. |
