#### **Strategic Intent:**

- 1. Facilitate and coordinate initial attack between incidents and units, maximizing lend-lease and the sharing of resources.
- 2. Maintain the investments made on long-term incidents when the reallocation of resources occurs.
- **3.** Forecast need for and manage IMTs to effectively respond to complex fires across the Geographic Area.
- **4.** Utilize surge resources for critical missions that maximize opportunities to safely meet incident objectives.
- **5.** Plan and make deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.

1	Initial Attack			Initial Attack is always the first priority.
2	Crescent Mountain	WA-OWF	Wilkins	Level III evacuations. Direct threat to structures in Twisp drainage. Significant growth to the southeast.
3	Watson Creek	OR-FWF	Sheldon	Level III evacuations for 15-20 residences. Active spread to southeast through commercial timber property. Elevated concerns for spread towards Paisley due to weather.
4	Cougar Creek	WA-OWF	Livingston	Level II evacuations for 700 structures which includes 580 residences. High concern with holding west line.
5	McLeod	WA-OWF	Wilkins	Threats to Mazama and Methow Valley.

8	Terwilliger	OR-WIF	Sinclair	3200 acres, eastside moving into wilderness. Westside moving towards commercial timberland.
9	Klondike West	OR-RSF	J. Kurth	Primary lines breached, implementing big box contingency.
10	Taylor Creek /Klondike East	OR-MED	T. Kurth	Level I, II and III evacuations. Moving resources to Klondike West.
11	Natchez	OR-RSF	Gales	Level I, II and III evacuations. Holding and improving containment lines.
12	Jennies Peak	OR-RFPN	Knerr	Widely scattered structures threatened.
13	Miriam	WA-OWF	Johnson	Level I and III evacuations. Implementing action on southeast corner. TOC to IMT3 8/25.
14	Miles	OR-UPF	Schulte	Level I evacuations. Reconsidering whether to execute firing operations. Heavy demob continues.
