- Maintain the investments made on long-term incidents when the reallocation of resources occurs.
- Facilitate and coordinate initial attack between incidents and units, maximizing lend-lease and the sharing of resources.
- Utilize surge resources for critical missions that maximize opportunities to safely meet incident objectives.
- Plan and make deliberate decisions on limited replacement or reallocation of shared resources from NMAC.
