### Strategic Intent:

Throughout the month of September, public and firefighter safety remains the highest priority:

- Maintain capacity for initial attack.
- Minimize firefighter exposure, protect communities and infrastructure, and maintain investments on long term incidents.
- Emphasize measures for mitigating fatigue and promoting continued safety awareness.

### PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Klondike West	OR-RSF	Dueitt	Level II evacuations for Agness. Continuing tactical firing operations as conditions allow.
3	Crescent Mountain	WA-OWF	Schulte	Mop-up and suppression repair ongoing. Road, trail and area closures remain.
4	Terwilliger	OR-WIF	Johnson	Mop-up and suppression repair ongoing. Road, trail and area closures remain.
5	Natchez	OR-RSF	Prummer	Mop-up and suppression repair ongoing. Road, trail and area closures remain. TOC to IMT3 early next week.
