6	Crane	OR-FWF	Dimke	Level 1, 2, 3 evacuations affecting limited structures.
7	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	Level 2 evacuation notice for 4 residences. Large spot fire and difficult terrain along NE flank.
8	White River	OR-MHF	Goff	No structures threatened. Spot fires contained.
9	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Inaccessible terrain. Several smaller fires controlled.
10	Steet Mtn/Laurel	OR-952S	Cline	Fires not challenging control efforts. One new IA response.
