3	Green Ridge	OR-DEF	Smith	Level 1, 2 evacuations in place. TOC to IMT1 this morning.
4	Palmer	WA-SPD	Sheldon	Level 1, 2, 3 evacuations; completing critical firing operations today.
5	Indian Creek	OR-VAD	Gales	Critical sage grouse habitat. Minor firing operations continue. Continue to secure lines on all flanks.
6	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Inaccessible terrain. Several smaller fires controlled. Added Rattlesnake incident; limited intel currently.
7	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	Level 2 evacuation notice for 4 residences. Establishing direct line with hand crews along NE flank.
8	White River	OR-MHF	Goff	Close to completing containment lines. Firing operation planned.
9	Crane	OR-FWF	Dimke	Level 1, 2, 3 evacuations affecting limited structures; being reevaluated today. Releasing some resources.
10	Steet Mtn/Laurel	OR-952S	Cline	All lines completed. Heavy mop-up underway.
