3	Green Ridge	OR-DEF	Smith	Level 1, 2 evacuations in place. Significant line construction activity on critical east flank. Spots occurring.
4	Palmer	WA-SPD	Sheldon	Level 1, 2, 3 evacuations. Completing critical firing operations around structures and interior pockets.
5	Indian Creek	OR-VAD	Gales	Critical sage grouse habitat. Securing lines on all flanks. Rapid spread potential with wind event today.
6	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Inaccessible terrain. Several smaller fires controlled. Recon/scout Rattlesnake to develop suppression plan.
7	White River	OR-MHF	Goff	Primary containment lines completed. Firing operations continue on east and west flanks.
8	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	Level 2 evacuation notice for 4 residences. Primary containment lines in place. Some contingency lines ongoing. Hold, improve and mop-up on all flanks.
