1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	P515/ Lionshead	OR-WSA	Knerr	Values at risk include residences, infrastructure, and cultural/natural resources to the east, south, and west. Minimal containment lines completed on Lionshead.
3	White River	OR-MHF	Goff	Primary containment lines completed. Uncontained spot fires challenging. Helicopter incident investigation in progress.
4	Green Ridge	OR-DEF	Smith	Evacuation notices remain in place. Plumbing completed on containment lines to support mop-up.
5	Palmer	WA-SPD	Sheldon	Assessing evacuation levels today. Mop-up and patrol. Some demob occurring.
6	Indian Creek	OR-VAD	Gales	Critical sage grouse habitat. Mopping hot spots on northwest/west flank.
7	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Inaccessible terrain. Several smaller fires controlled. Anchor point established on Rattlesnake.
8	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	Level 2 evacuation notice for 4 residences. Hold, improve, mop-up on all flanks. No additional resource needs.
