

Strategic Intent

• Continue to realign resources as incidents begin to meet objectives.

PNW Incident Priorities (set daily):

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	Rationale
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	P515/ Lionshead	OR-WSA	Knerr	Values at risk include residences, infrastructure, and cultural/natural resources to the east and south. Expected decrease in containment on Lionshead. Continued progress on P515.
3	White River	OR-MHF	Goff	Fire jumped containment line, rapid growth towards values at risk. Inbrief with IMT 1 8/27/2020 @ 1800.
4	Palmer	WA-SPD	Sheldon	Evacuation levels remain. Mop-up and patrol continues.
5	Green Ridge	OR-DEF	Smith	Lifting evacuations. Mop-up all divisions.
6	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Inaccessible terrain. Direct and indirect line construction continues. Progress being made.
7	Indian Creek	OR-VAD	Gales	Critical sage grouse habitat. Mopping hot spots on northwest/west flank. Patrol south and east.
8	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	All evacuation levels have been dropped. Hold, improve, mop-up on all flanks.
9	Steet Mtn/Laurel	OR-952S	Cline	Patrol and Mop-up. Releasing resources. TOC 8/28/2020.
