6	Meacham Complex	OR-UMF	Almas	Direct and indirect line construction continues. Progress being made.
7	Indian Creek	OR-VAD	Gales	Mopping hot spots on northwest/west flanks. Patrol south and east. TOC 8/30 to IMT3.
8	Frog	OR-OCF	Johnson	Hold, improve, mop-up on all flanks. TOC 8/30 T4.
