**Strategic Intent**

- Continue to provide for initial attack while supporting large fire incidents. Pinch points may develop due to increased critical burn environment.

**PNW Incident Priorities (*set daily*):**

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Fire</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>IC</u>	<u>Rationale</u>
1	Initial Attack			Initial attack is always the first priority.
2	Evans Canyon	WA-SES	Dimke	Level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Structures threatened, very active burning conditions.
3	P515/Lionshead	OR-WSA	Lawson	No evacuation levels in place. Scouting opportunities in southwest corner that threatens Metolius River Canyon.
4	Beachie Creek	OR-WIF	Gales	Assessing structure protection around Jawbone Flats. Closures not fully implemented.
5	White River	OR-MHF	Livingston	Level 1 and 2 evacuation notices. Containment lines adjacent to structures are secure. Making progress.
6	Sweet Creek MP2	OR-781S	Hessel	Reevaluating level 1, 2 and 3 evacuations. Road and area closures. Fire is lined and plumbed. Ongoing mop-up.
