4	Lionshead	OR-WSA	Livingston	Level 2 evacs west of Hwy 26 and level 1 to the east. TOC IMT1 9/17 @ 2000.
5	Brattain	OR-FWF	Goldman	Reduced threat to community of Paisley. Evacuation levels remain.
