2	Beachie Creek	OR-WIF	Livingston	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair. Hot spotting Mother Lode fire.
3	Riverside	OR-MHF	Livingston	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair. Building contingency lines.
4	Lionshead	OR-WSA	Gales	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair. Building contingency lines.
5	Holiday Farm	OR-WIF	Hessel	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair. Improving line, going direct where possible.
6	Archie Creek	OR-UPF	Dueitt	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
7	Thielsen	OR-UPF	Dueitt	Mop-up, patrol, and suppression repair.
